

C. NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

Lake of the Ozarks Developmental Center posts Title VI notices in public areas of our agency, and in our agency vehicles.

Lake of the Ozarks Developmental Center operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by Lake of the Ozarks Developmental Center, you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with Lake of the Ozarks Developmental Center:

1. A grievance form is available at our office facility at 1867 S. Business Highway 5, Camdenton, MO 65020 or by calling 573-346-4574, ask for the Title VI Program Officer and one can be mailed to you.
2. In addition to the complaint process at Lake of the Ozarks Developmental Center, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, and Region 7, 901 Locust Street, Suite 404, Kansas City, MO 64106 or telephone 816-329-3920.
3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
